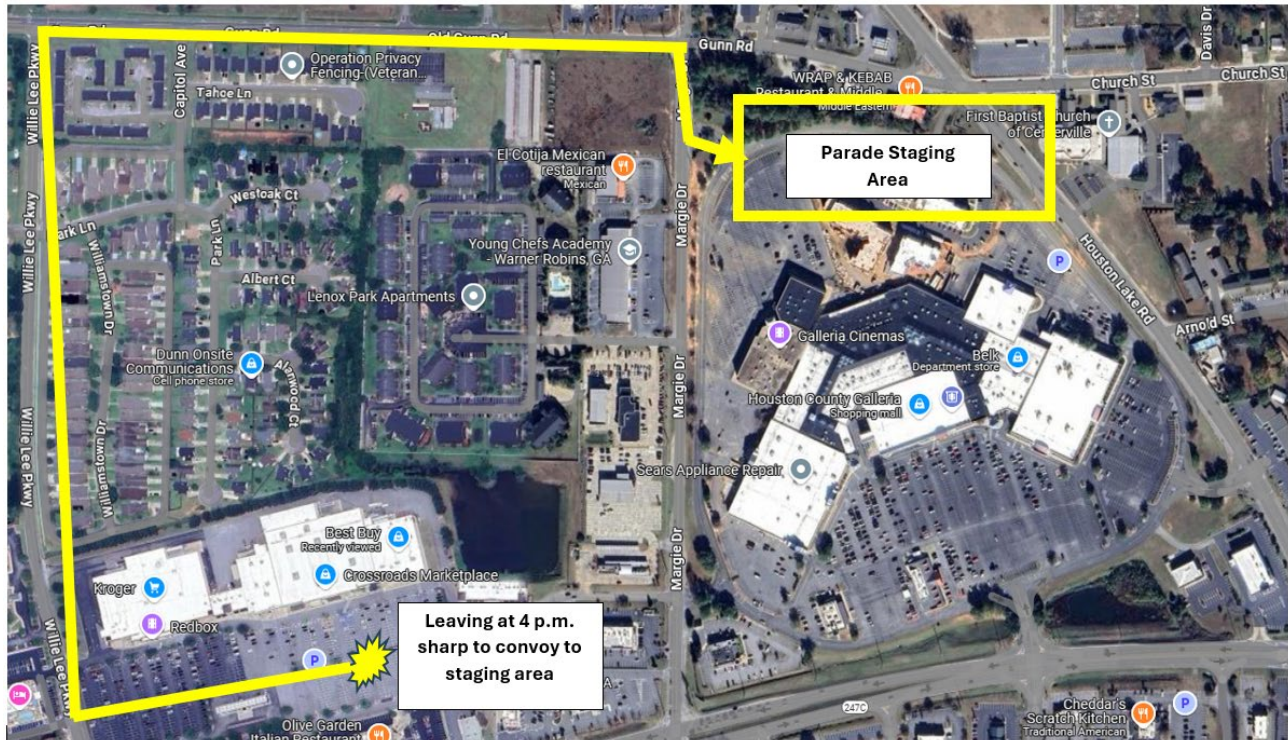

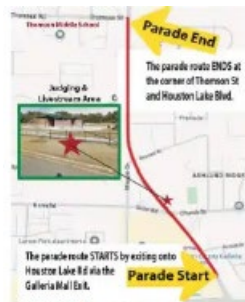


Your jeep has to be decorated. Buy LED lights as they require less power. Santa inflatables are allowed.
